Full-Time Ministry Team Info

The ministry team is the core staff of Lampost. They live together in a discipleship community at our home base. Here they carry out the daily activities and special events of the theatre/coffeehouse, participate in outreach projects, and serve as the central force in our creative performance ensemble.

Core Concepts

Members of the ministry team must be sold out to ministry and service as a way of life. By living in community, we foster an atmosphere of mutual discipleship and accountability. We become a body devoted to one another in prayer, study, and work. Out of that context, members serve in everything from performing on stage to working in the office to cleaning toilets.

We are looking for creative missionaries to impact a postmodern world with a genuine counter-cultural lifestyle. Out of that lifestyle, the Lord leads us into effective creative outreach.

Responsibilities/Activities

may include but are by no means limited to:

- participating in theatrical productions
- developing creative weekly programming
- touring performances at colleges, churches, conferences
- operating coffee shop ministry
- working with college campus outreach
- media/video production
- office/management responsibilities
- leading/aiding in discipleship programs, workshops, Bible studies
- participation in training of missionaries for cross-cultural evangelism
- developing creative ways to proclaim the Gospel to a spiritually deaf and intellectually blind generation

Qualifications

You must have a sold-out passion to serve, an inclination to create, and the gumption to try just about anything. Each role on the team is unique, and your role will be partially defined by the gifts and interests God has given you for ministry.

Financial Info

Team members are provided with basic living expenses, food and housing.

Stipend/salary varies based on individual need, and can be supplemented by a variety of options, including support-based methods.

Because of the nature of support-based ministry, consult Lampost first if you have substantial debt (such as excessive student loans or credit payments).

Procedure

1. Pray about your involvement. The fields are ripe, and God has given us a work to do. Is this your opportunity to "Go into the world and make disciples?"
2. Contact Lampost with a resume and a brief indication of why you are interested in joining the ministry team.
3. Complete an application and related materials. These will be sent to you after your resume is received.
4. If your application is being considered, we will contact you with further information and questions. Usually there is a brief phone interview followed by more extensive interviews and an audition either in person or by video.
